# THE LEARNING CENTER TESTING POLICY FOR STUDENTS

## ACCOMMODATIONS (STUDENTS W/ DOCUMENTED DISABILITIES), CONSORTIUM, ONLINE CLASS STUDENTS & MAKE-UP TESTS

Thank you for using the testing services offered by the Learning Center. We are happy to assist you with your educational journey here at SUNY Ulster.

To make your testing experience as easy as possible, here are a few policies with which you should become familiar.

#### Accommodations testing (students w/ documented disabilities)

- We will proctor scheduled exams for students with accommodations throughout the week during our office hours (8:30 am 4:30 pm).
- If you are a student who needs special testing accommodations, you must make arrangements with the Learning Center (VAN 247) in person, or email <a href="mailto:lac@sunyulster.edu">lac@sunyulster.edu</a> or <a href="mailto:dziombas@sunyulster.edu">dziombas@sunyulster.edu</a>, or call 845-687-5131/5039 at least two days in advance.
- Students who have an accommodation that allows for extended testing time, but have another scheduled class that conflicts with this accommodation, should arrange another test time with the approval of the instructor and the LC staff.

### Consortium/Online class testing

You must make an appointment <u>at least two days in advance</u> with the Learning Center (VAN 247) in person, or email <u>lac@sunyulster.edu</u> or <u>dziombas@sunyulster.edu</u>, or call 845-687-5131. Space availability is limited and this allows the LC staff an opportunity to make sure your test has been delivered to the Learning Center.

#### Make-up testing

- Please be aware of the Learning Center's testing schedule for make-up exams.
- Appointments must be made at least two days in advance.

Tuesdays and Wednesdays: 9:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. (All exams must end by 3:00 pm)

#### Additional policies for testing in the Learning Center

- You will be asked to leave all books, cell phones, PDAs, and notes outside the testing area.
- You will not be allowed to use the LC computers while testing unless use of a computer is part of the
  accommodation or special instruction from faculty.
- You will be required to leave all completed tests with the LC staff.

- Students should plan accordingly to have sufficient time to complete all tests.
