This camp offers the opportunity for campers to explore the wonderful world of art through an introduction to a variety of art materials, processes, and genres. Campers draw, paint, print, sculpt, and create mixed media projects that are inspired by art history and each camper's personal expression and choice of subject matter. All skill levels are welcome.

Educational Leader: Doreen Diorio is a New York State Certified Art Teacher with a master's degree from Teachers College, Columbia University, and membership in Kappa Delta Pi, the international education society. She has taught art for 25 years for the New York City Board of Education, for the public library, and presently for Washington-Saratoga BOCES Project Enrich. Ms. Diorio has published numerous art education articles, stories and illustrations and has been awarded NYSCA, DEC, and Puffin grants for her art projects. Her paintings and mixed media art have been exhibited in such spaces as the Kleinert-James Gallery, WAAM, The Williamsburg Art and Historical Center, The Crocker Art Museum, and in Brooklyn's Grand Army Plaza Arch.
