This driver training course is approved by the NYS Education Department Traffic Safety Unit and the New York State Department of Motor Vehicles. The 48-hour course includes:

- ★ 24 hours of in-car instruction including 6 hours behind-the-wheel instruction and 18 hours of in-car observation.
- ★ 24 hours of classroom instruction.

Classroom and driving are held on alternating days, Monday through Friday. Upon completion, students will receive a certificate, which may allow a reduction in your insurance. This program is administered in cooperation with an area auto school.
